In today's high-tech world, the best way to discover whether or not you're at imminent risk for a heart attack is to have a 64-Slice CT Scan.

There are two kinds, a "Calcium Score," and a "CT Angiography." (Both are excellent, but if you test positive – above 150 on the Calcium Score – you're probably going to want the second test.)

The Calcium Score will tell you FOR SURE whether you have calcified hard plaque build-up. (No other test can tell you this.)

The CT Angiography will tell you how much TOTAL plaque build-up you have (both hard and soft), where it is located, how much blockage is present, and how it should be treated.

And both are far more predictive than a stress test.
